PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION/OBJECTIVE

Young people are among the most vulnerable in society. Particularly during a serious economic downturn 1 out of 5 children live in families that are at risk of poverty, and more than one third of young adults (18 and 24) in the European Union are currently unemployed and not in education, employment or training. Social exclusion doesn't just affect people who are materially deprived. Approximately 1 out of every 3 people in the Europe face social exclusion. Creating an inclusive community was a primary goal in the process of European integration from its start and the latest economic crisis placed new weight on this objective. According to the current situation social service is obligated to develop new and creative approaches to build inclusive communities for youth, considering also innovative approaches like digitalization.
