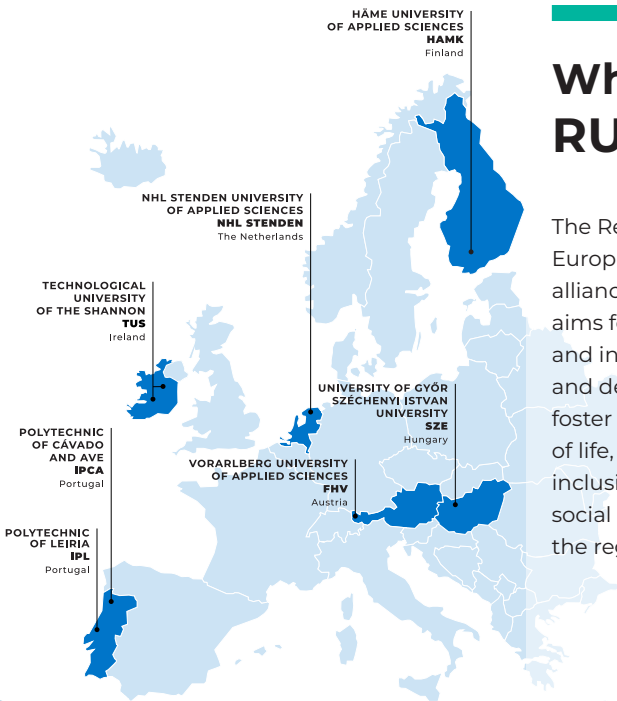

## What are the RUN-EU Opportunities for teachers?

RUN-EU provides a range of exciting opportunities for teachers to enhance their skills, gain valuable experiences, and broaden their horizons.

At the heart of RUN-EU's teacher development initiatives is the Future and Advanced Skills Academies (FASA), which offers pedagogical competence development opportunities to teachers across the alliance.
