SAP OVERVIEW

This SAP Research Challenge aims to promote the development of in-person R&D activities focused on the discussion of new challenges and critical perspectives in Accounting and Finance Research. The emerging challenges in A&F research under the digital transformation and the green transition will be explored and debated in different critical perspectives during this programme. The SAP program is divided into two components: training and group research. The training component will be based on short thematic workshops taught by academics and experts. These workshops will focus on emerging the agenda on Accounting and Finance-related research topics (namely, digital and dialogic accounting, accountability and reporting on SDGs, green tax, finance topics, entrepreneurship, and communication) and training in basic research components (namely, Research Methodologies, Data Analysis, Scientific Writing, Preparation of Scientific Pitches, and Funding Opportunities).
