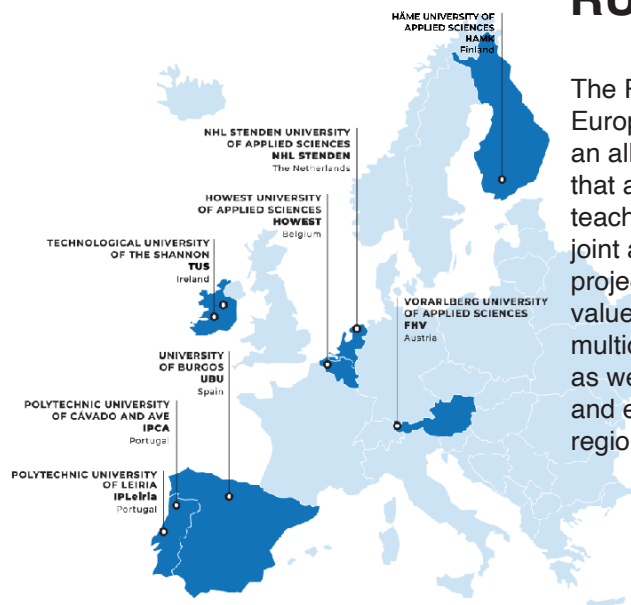

The Regional University Network - European University (RUN-EU) is an alliance of European universities that aims for excellence in research, teaching, and innovation, promotes joint activities and development of projects that foster European Union values and way of life, including multiculturalism and inclusiveness, as well as the sustainable social and economic development of the regions.

What are the RUN-EU Study Programmes?

There are various opportunities available, ranging from exchange programmes for one semester to collaborating with international students from RUN-EU partner institutions on projects or participating in one of our learning opportunities, either on-site or online.

Are you looking for a short international experience?

Then enrol in a Short Advanced Programme (SAP) for one to eight weeks or explore any of our other learning opportunities, such as COILs (Collaborative Online International Learning), BIPs (Blended Intensive Programmes), or Youth Exchange Schools (YES).

During these programmes, you will immerse yourself in a challenging subject for a short period. The topics are as diverse as the students you will work with, and the theme does not necessarily need to align with your current study programme. Your fresh perspective can be valuable!

As a student, you can also participate in one of the joint degree

programmes. If you choose a joint degree, you will receive a single diploma awarded by all the higher education institutions offering the Joint Programme.

What do you get out of it?

RUN-EU offers a unique chance to study alongside students from all partner institutions and is an excellent opportunity to expand your network. You may also apply to be part of the RUN-EU Student Council, where you will gain practical experience in working in an intercultural environment. These skills will be beneficial for your future career and enhance your prospects in the job market.
